

### **AFTER SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM**



Elmore Primary School has reached out to us to let us know that OSHClub will now be offering an After-School Care Program onsite at their school. Arrangements are currently be made to transport any students from OLSH that would like to use the service to Elmore PS of an afternoon.

The session cost for care is \$28, however the service is eligible for child care subsidy. After subsidy, you could be out of pocket as little as only \$4.20 (based on maximum rebate). Sessions run from the end of the school day through to 6pm.

More information, including booking information, will be sent out when these arrangements have been finalised.

Please include the days of the week you would be interested in enrolling your child/ren as well as contact name and mobile number that we can pass on to Elmore Primary School if needed.

Please <u>DO NOT complete any online enrolment</u> for your child/ren until we notify the community that arrangements have been finalised.

### **CONVEYANCE ALLOWANCE PROGRAM (CAP) 2022**

The Conveyance Allowance is a form of financial assistance from the Victorian State Government to assist families in rural and regional Victoria with the cost of transporting their children to their nearest appropriate school. The allowance is available to parents who are required to –



- drive their child more than 4.8 kilometres to school (if there is no school bus)
- or drive their child more than 4.8 kilometres to meet the nearest school bus to the school
- the child must attend their closest government or non-government school (Catholic)
- the allowance is based on kilometres travelled and not based on any financial eligibility

Distance is calculated by the shortest practical route from home to the school or from home to meet the nearest school bus to the school. Distance can be calculated by using Bing Maps. Application Forms are available from the school office and must be completed by a parent/guardian.

Parents who received the Conveyance Allowance in 2021 do not need to complete a new form in 2022 unless their children enrolled at OLSH in 2022 have changed (i.e. Gr 6 student left at the end of 2021 or a Foundation child commenced in 2022). If your family circumstances have changed, a new form needs to be completed in 2022. If you have recently changed address please advise the office if you are no longer eligible. Application and Authority to Pay forms need to be completed and returned to the office by Friday 11 March 2022 please.

### **CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)**

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities. If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per primary school student is \$125.

**HOW TO APPLY**: New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the site listed below. If you received a CSEF payment in in 2021, you do not need to complete an application form in 2022 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances or your concession card details.
