From the Principal ...

Dear Families,

The week certainly flies following a long weekend! It feels a bit crazy that we only have one week to go of this term. Where did that go??

MID - YEAR REPORTS

We are aiming to have our midyear reports home on Tuesday 21st June. The only reason that this may not happen is due to technology difficulties but fingers crossed that this is not the case.

As a school we have noted that absenteeism is at higher levels than in most previous years. This is very easily explained with the impact of COVID 19 and close contact regulations in Term 1 and then the flu which has been doing the rounds in Term 2, as well as the ongoing nature of COVID.

HELLO BABY

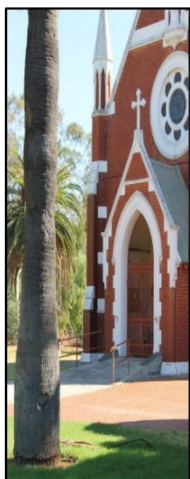
CONGRATULATIONS
