ADVENT

The first week of Advent begins on Sunday 28th November. Advent is also the beginning of a new liturgical year in the church calendar. The church has three liturgical cycles: A, B and C. This year we will be return to Year A, which focuses on the Gospel of Matthew.

The word 'Advent' means 'coming'. When we light the candles on the wreath, it symbolises the coming of light (Jesus) into the world.

Candle 1 (violet): represents hope Candle 2 (violet): represents peace Candle 3 (rose): represents joy Candle 4 (violet): represents love The central white candle is lit on Christmas Day and represents Christ.



Advent is a special time in the church year when we prepare and get ready to celebrate the birth of Jesus.



God, you give us hope. As we light this candle in your name, we ask you to help us share hope with family and friends this Advent. Amen

This Advent we will learn, act and pray for a more just and fair world – a world full of hope, peace, joy, and love.


BOOK CLUB ISSUE 8 - ORDERS DUE TOMORROW
