- Sunday - **Easter Sunday** - The day that Jesus rose from the dead and was truly acknowledged as the son of God.


ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING ON SEESAW

We enter into a week made "holy" forever by the self-surrendering love of Jesus - for us all.


