Below is an email received from Department of Education that we have been asked to share in regards to the online School Bus Management System.

### "Dear Families

Important update for students who are approved for travel on the School Bus Program: Upgrades are being made to the School Bus Management System (SBMS).

To make this important change, the SBMS will be unavailable from COB Friday 5 May 2023 for a period of time.

If you need help during this time, you can email the School Bus Program team on schoolbus@education.vic.gov.au or call on 1800 338 663."

The outage will only affect bus users if they need to make changes to an existing traveller's details (such as a residential address) or make a new application.

We have not been given a date for when the system will be back online.
