

Out School Hours Care Support Elmore Field Days Volunteers

OSHClub operates a daily afterschool care service for all school aged children in Elmore from 3.20pm - 6pm.

The venue for this is Elmore Primary School. Students attending Our Lady of Sacred Heart PS can be transported to the venue by Dysons bus service (at no cost) at the end of their school day.

This service is not open to kindergarten aged students.

We are currently seeking an Expression of Interest (EOI) for families to use this service for the for the 3 days of the Elmore Field Days, October 3 -5th.

This service will be gap free - meaning there will be no out of pocket expense for families.
