WORLD YOUTH DAY 2023 – AUG 1ST – 6TH

World Youth Day (WYD) is the gathering of young people from all over the world with the Pope. It is a pilgrimage, a celebration of youth, an expression of the universal Church. Although its Catholic identity is clearly evident, WYD opens its doors to everyone, no matter how close to or distant from the Church they are.

Since its first edition in Rome in 1986, WYD has been celebrated every two, three or four years as an international gathering in a city chosen by the Pope. This year's WYD will be held in Lisbon, Portugal, with events beginning August 1st 2023. It brings together millions of young people to celebrate their faith and sense of belonging to the Church.

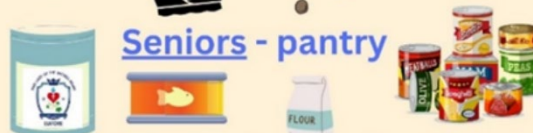
